Vic horse owners need codes

IT IS now compulsory for all Victorian horse owners to have a Property Identification Code detailing where they keep their horses.

The new legislation came into effect at the start of this month. The PIC will provide the **Department of Primary Industries** with information on Victoria's livestock populations as well as contact details for owners. Moves for a PIC were triggered by the equine influenza outbreak in 2007 and last year's Black Saturday bushfires, when many horses were killed, displaced or not found.

Applying for a PIC is free. Application forms are available at www.dpi.vic.gov.au or by phoning 1800 678 779. They can also be picked up at DPI offices. On the form, owners will need to supply their name, address and other contact details, and also the council property number or rates assessment number of the property where the horse will be kept. Owners need to indicate that the property is used for horses, by ticking under Horses in the Livestock Type box, and entering the number of horses on the property. In the case of properties where horses are kept occasionally, such as showgrounds or pony clubs, simply indicate on the form that horses are kept there from time to time, but enter zero for the number at present. Applicants will be sent a card detailing their PIC. Unlike production livestock, no tracking of movement of horses between properties is envisaged.

Existing PICs: There is no need for properties that have an existing PIC to apply for another. If you are not sure, phone the DPI Helpline on 1800 678 779. If there is already a PIC, you can advise that horses are running on it.

Agistment: If multiple horses with different owners are agisted on one property it will be sufficient for the owner of the agistment property to apply and hold a PIC. However, the owners of the agisted horses will need to satisfy themselves of this. It will soon be possible for PIC holders to view a list of Victorian PICs online, which will help this process.

Racecourses and training stables: Provided each course and stable is covered by a PIC, which could involve a listing of all relevant council property numbers on one application, the obligation will be deemed to have been met.

One owner of separate blocks: One PIC will cover all of the blocks they own and run horses on. There is no need to apply separately for each block as long as they are in the same locality. Horse owners will need to regularly supply DPI with updates about their numbers and any changes to the parcels of land to which the PIC applies.

Competitions

Please do not compete in polar fleece jumpers as they do not show PCAV logo and could mean disqualification. Riders can compete in their polo shirts. It is recommended that when doing a dressage test that riders wear a shirt, tie & club woollen jumper. It does make a difference with the judge!

Unmounted Rally Attendance

Those riders who wish to gain an unmounted rally attendance must stay with their group for two sessions and must be in uniform.

Medical Arm Bands

Medical armbands are compulsory at all rallies. This is a reminder that the official medical Armband **MUST** be worn at rallies. Makeshift or no medical armbands are not acceptable and will mean that you won't be able to ride. A supply of Medical Armbands is available through Kaye McQueen who also looks after the uniforms. **Don't forget to get your 2009 colour coded insert for your armband**

First Aid & Accidents at Rallies

All accidents that occur at rallies whether while riding, while around your horses or just walking on the grounds must be reported to Jane Apter.

Back Protectors

Back protectors must be worn at all times when jumping at our grounds, even when training.

Gear Check

Please be aware that all riders are required to be in the junior yard for their gear check by 11.30am. We need all gear checked and riders to move on to their areas so that the juniors can start on time.

Grading

If you are planning to be graded for competition riding, please let the DC, Lisa know at the start of the rally. A phone call before hand allows Lisa to properly plan for grading.

Use of the Trotter's Area (Including Inside The Track)

There are a few rules that we wish to remind you of when using the area near the trotting club sheds and inside the track:

- The wash area is not meant to be used by club members but if it is used please always remove any manure.
- Members can use the gravel area in front of the sheds, as long as you do not block access to the yards. Again please pick up any manure and put it in the small manure shed.
- No vehicle should cross the track unless it is there to set up equipment. This rule is in place because the tyre tracks in the sand in particular when it rains can cause young trotting horses to jump the tracks. This is very dangerous for horse and driver.
- Club members are not to use the inside of the track before 10.30am every day unless they have approval from the trotting club.

I know that sometimes these rules can be a pain but we are very lucky to share facilities with the Trotting Club and so it would be great if members could remember these rules when using this area. Thanks.

Grounds reserved for Adult Riding Club

The grounds are reserved on the second Saturday of every month between 11.30am and 5.00pm for adult riders only. Please be sure to keep the grounds free for their use.
