Open riders

Riders participating in the open competition must pay a \$15 day attendance fee (per day), unless they can provide evidence of current:

- PCAV membership or
- Other approved insurance such as EA, AHSA, AERA, HRC AV or interstate pony club member.
- Day participant waiver form available at www.yhpc.org.au.
- **All** participants in an open competition, including pony club members, must sign a public liability declaration form available at www.yhpc.org.au
- Proof of current membership must be presented at the secretary's desk prior to competing.

Conditions of entry

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
2. Bridle or saddle cloth numbers must be displayed on both sides of the horse & riders to provide their own.
3. Grading cards must be presented prior to riding.
4. Approved helmets must be worn.
5. Medical Arm Bands are optional. Please submit an emergency contact when entering.
6. Competitors must present to GEAR CHECK 20 mins. prior to each phase.
7. Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.
8. All refunds will incur a \$10 administration fee .No refunds after closing unless scratching notified prior to ride time and a valid veterinary or medical certificate supplied within 7 days of notification to kslade@eventsecretary.com.au
9. Entries will be accepted in order they are received. The committee reserve the right to close entries to any grade and or section prior to the closing date upon the allotted number of entries in a section or grade being reached.
10. No Lunging permitted.
11. The organising committee reserve the right to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.
12. NO DOGS PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS
13. Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs. Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws
