Open Riders

Riders participating in the open competition must pay a \$15 day attendance fee (per day), unless they can provide evidence of current:

-PCAV membership or

-Other approved insurance such as EA, AHSA, AERA, HRC AV or interstate pony club member.

-All participants in an open competition, including pony club members, must sign a public liability declaration form available at <http://ponyvic.omnisportsmanagement.com/en-au/forclubs/runacompetition/dayparticipants.aspx>

-Proof of current membership must be presented at the secretary's desk prior to competing.

Yards & Camping

Camping is allowed. Generator use restricted to 7am-10pm

Overnight yards can be pre-booked online for a fee of \$20 for the weekend.

Conditions of entry

1. Competition conducted under PCV Horse Trials Rules (January 2019)
2. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
3. The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition, divide any class, alter times, refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
4. Competitors must be prepared to ride earlier than scheduled if required
5. No refunds after closing date without vet/medical certificate. Vet/medical certificate must be provided within 5 days.
6. A non-refundable \$10 scratching fee will apply to all scratchings
7. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCV Handbook of By-laws, multiple horse rules.
8. Complying helmets must be worn, spot checks may occur.
9. Gear check required for all riders before each phase .
10. Current PCAV, EA, AHSA, AERA HRC AV membership cards must be presented to secretary. No card, no ride.
11. Open Riders who do not have PCAV, EA, AHSA, AERA, HRC AV insurance must complete the Day Participation Form, and pay \$15 per day.
12. Riders must be eight years of age to compete, horses must be at least four years of age, no stallions, colts or rigs.
13. The Organising Committee will supply allocated number/s. **Competitors MUST supply their own back number holder which must be worn in all three phases.**
14. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
15. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
16. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCV Handbook of Bylaws.
17. Lunging is not permitted.
18. Neither the Organising Committee of this competition, nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
19. Combined training is for Riders 12 & under only.
20. All riders must supply a volunteer as a condition of entry. Riders not supplying a volunteer will not be guaranteed a ride.
21. It is the responsibility of the rider to be available for presentation. Rugs, Ribbons & Prizes not collected will not be posted.
